BRUT ROSÉ SPARKLING WINE	New Release	Crafted in the méthode champenoise style and harvested early, this stunning wine spent a year en tirage before being disgorged. This fresh and rediant Brut Rosé shimmers with layers of strawberry, summer melon and orange blossom.
CHARDONNAY	92 points James Suckling, v22	Crafted using grapes from some of the most acclaimed sites on the cool, windswept Sonoma Coast, including our Running Creek estate vineyard. This wine displays lovely stone fruit aromas, along with hints of apple and citrus, finishing with a beam of cool-climate acidity providing poise and finesse
PINOT NOIR	91 points Wine Enthusiast, v21	Bright, polished and impeccably balanced, this wine embodies the depth and nuance of the finest Sonoma Coast Pinot Noirs. The nose offers a melange of black raspberry, Bing cherry, rhubarb and forest floor aromas, along with hints of holiday spice. On the palate, velvety tannins carry the lush, flowing flavors to a vibrant fruit and spice finish.
MERLOT	93 points James Suckling, v21	This vibrant and alluring Merlot draws you in with fragrances of ripe raspberry, Bing cherry and red currant, as well as notions of cedar and sweet baking spice from oak aging. On the palate, velvety tannins accentuate the generous red berry and spice flavors as they flow to a long, juicy finish.
RED WINE	91 points Wine Enthusiast, v19	This ripe and expressive blend draws you in with dramatic aromas of blackberry pie, cherry, brambly spice, clove, and a touch of cinnamon. The red and black fruit layers are echoed on the beautifully balanced palate, where they are framed by rich, silky tannins and a streak of bright acidity that carries the flavors to a long, lush finish
CABERNET SAUVIGNON	94 <sub>points</sub> Wine Enthusiast, v21	Embodying the luxurious beauty of great Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, this alluring wine draws you in with complex aromas of black cherry, ripe plum, blackberry, and sweet baking spices. On the palate, the tannins are supple and round, framing juicy layers of dark berries and chocolate, with sophisticated hints of white pepper and toasty oak emerging throughout the long, resonant finish.
