## MT. HARLAN WINES

Since 1975, Calera has remained true to its distinctive style, crafting age-worthy Pinot Noirs, recognized for their balance, elegance, and terroir-driven complexity. Longtime Winemaker Mike Waller and his team apply a gentle, minimalist approach that includes native yeast, whole cluster, and modest new oak. The resulting 2020 wines are graceful, sophisticated, complex, and built to age.



### 2020 MT. HARLAN PINOT NOIR JENSEN VINEYARD

ABV: 14.5%   pH: 3.77   Oak: 18 months

At more than 40 years old, the coveted old vines of Jensen Vineyard have produced a stunning wine that offers both depth and elegance. Aromas of wild strawberry, rhubarb, pomegranate, and black cherry leap from the glass, beckoning a first sip. On the palate, the flavors turn deep and dark, with layers of blueberry, juicy blackberry, and cocoa that build to a long, dramatic finish.

### 2020 MT. HARLAN PINOT NOIR DE VILLIERS VINEYARD

ABV: 14.1%   pH: 3.67   Oak: 18 months

Once again, de Villiers has produced a gorgeous dark-fruit expression of Pinot Noir from Mt. Harlan. On the nose, aromas of candied blackberry, ripe strawberry, and black cherry mingle with hints of white pepper and spice. The palate is smooth with velvety tannins and dramatic flavors of blackberry, cedar, and saffras, driving to a long, impeccably balanced finish.

## 2020 MT. HARLAN PINOT NOIR RYAN VINEYARD

ABV: 14.2%    pH: 3.71    Oak: 18 months

The Ryan Vineyard sits at the highest point of Mt. Harlan (reaching 2,500 feet) and features vines that were planted in 1998 with a southwestern exposure. Though young by Calera standards, these more than 20-year-old vines yield a beautifully complex Pinot Noir, with cherry and plum layers framed by age-worthy tannins.

## 2020 MT. HARLAN PINOT NOIR MILLS VINEYARD

ABV: 13.9%    pH: 3.71    Oak: 18 months

This 2020 Mt. Harlan Pinot Noir comes from the 14-acre, southeast-facing Mills Vineyard, which was planted in 1984 at an elevation of 2,200 feet. At over 35 years of age, these low-yielding vines produced an effortlessly complex wine with energy, elegance, and sophisticated nuances of minerals, herbs, and spices.

## 2020 MT. HARLAN CHARDONNAY

ABV: 13.9%    pH: 3.53    Oak: 15 months

Grown high on the limestone-rich soils of Mt. Harlan, this beautifully aromatic wine displays layers of Honeycrisp apple, peach, and fresh brioche. The apple and stone fruit layers are echoed on the palate, with undercurrents of cedar, wet stone, and spice, adding nuance and complexity to a long, resonant finish. To preserve the wine's more delicate aspects, this Chardonnay was aged in 30% new French oak with minimal lees stirring.
