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WINE DESCRIPTION

Our Napa Valley Merlot is a complex blend of several individual vineyard lots. The final wine is a rich and cohesive expression of the entire appellation.	Our Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of individual vineyard lots, utilizing exceptional fruit from our estate vineyards and independent growers. The final wine is a classic expression of the Napa Valley.	Focusing on vibrant citrus flavors, we source fruit from various microclimates. Barrel fermentation and the addition of Sémillon result in a full-flavored wine exhibiting balanced acidity and bright fruit.	Sourced from the coolest regions of Napa, in the cellar we applied classic techniques of French Oak barrel fermentation with lees stirring, resulting in a Chardonnay that balances the complexity and richness of Napa Valley.	Our first Merlot from Three Palms was our inaugural 1978 vintage, beginning over a quarter century of tradition crafting full-bodied wines that reflect the unique terroir of this site.	Recognized as one of the Napa Valley's most acclaimed winegrowing regions, grapes from Howell Mountain are famous for producing age-worthy Red Wines with rich, deep color and excellent structure.	The Discussion Estate Grown Napa Valley Red Wine is a blend 30 years in the making and represents the pinnacle of the Duckhorn Vineyards portfolio and the ongoing dialogue that defines great winemaking.
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TASTING NOTES

This wine displays juicy layers of Bing cherry, raspberry and plum, along with hints of blueberry, cedar, vanilla and clove. Underscored by polished tannins, the juiciness of the entry evolves into a lush, silky texture that carries the flavors to a long, generous finish.	Beginning with a gorgeous berry nose with cedar, sage and licorice, this is a lush and lively Cabernet. On the palate, the alluring fruit flavors are underscored by bright acidity, firm polished tannins and notes of fig, licorice and cinnamon that linger on the well-structured finish.	Enticing aromas of grapefruit, melon and lime leap from the glass, followed by tropical notes of lychee, pineapple and passionfruit. On the palate, this Sauvignon Blanc is juicy and bright, with silky layers of fruit balanced by lovely natural acidity and a vibrant streak of minerality.	Inviting aromas of pear, lemongrass, ripe peach, jasmine and graham cracker rise from the glass, revealing this wine's layered complexity. On the palate, a silky texture creates weight and volume, with elegant acidity framing the stone fruit and citrus flavors. The finish is long and fresh, with hints of lemon zest, vanilla and clove.	This wine displays captivating aromas of fresh cranberry, blueberry, fig, cedar and cocoa nibs. On the dense, mouth-filling palate, sophisticated notes of wet slate minerality add poise and definition to flavors of plum, molasses, cherry and crushed rose petals that lead to a beautiful finish.	This wine displays aromas of blackberry, boysenberry and raspberry, as well as hints of holiday baking spices and cocoa powder. Bold and full-bodied on the palate, with firm tannins, this impeccably structured wine offers lush, flowing flavors of black cherry and cassis that carry through to a long, jammy finish.	This inviting wine reveals aromas of cinnamon, nutmeg, caramel and cocoa powder with fresh boysenberry, currant and ripe red plum. The flavors are every bit as complex, with layers of blackberry, plum, licorice, vanilla and violet accentuated by elegant tannins and a plush, velvety texture, that leads to a long, satisfying finish.
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
