Winemaking & Sourcing: We source our fruit from some of the preeminent vineyards around the small but highly acclaimed 600 acre AVA, including Ambassador, Shaw, Quintessence, Kiona, Canyons, Obelisco and Klipsun. Klipsun was named by *Wine & Spirits* magazine as one of the Top 100 Vineyards in the US.

Tasting Notes: This wine begins with effusive aromas of blackberry, marionberry and black cherry. As it evolves, layers of mocha, cinnamon and clove reveal themselves, as well as hints of sarsaparilla and black licorice, all of which frame the fruit, while adding depth and nuance. The palate is supple and juicy, with a voluminous texture, hedonistic black fruit and a complex French oak-inspired spice box note that carries through to a long and sophisticated finish.
