Winemaking & Sourcing: Planted in 1975, Jensen Vineyard features some of the oldest Pinot Noir vines on the Central Coast. With average yields of less than 1.5 tons per acre, this celebrated winegrowing site produces a complex and impeccably balanced expression of Pinot Noir that is famed for its uncommon age-worthiness. The wine was aged without racking in 30% new French oak, for 18 months.	Tasting Notes: This 2014 Jensen vineyard Pinot Noir has a fabulous nose; beautiful integrated, seamless aromas of dark fruits, sweet oak, mineral, black cherry pie and mesquite. The texture is round and broad with many layers; the flavors are bright and perfumey, the structure is very fine grained and smooth. This wine is complete even so young, and promises a very long life ahead in the cellar.
