

2017 KOSTA BROWNE SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Alcohol: 14.2%

PH: 3.52

TA: 5.00g/L

SRP: \$100-120

Winemaker Notes: The Sonoma Coast appellation overlaps with that of the Russian River Valley in many places and is similarly shaped by the ocean. Local geology can be complex here, a direct result of being located on the intersection of two tectonic plates. For this wine, we find ourselves drawn to vineyards that are particularly influenced by the Pacific Ocean and are fortunate to work with some spectacular sites. Together, they form a singular wine that is distinctively Sonoma Coast.

Vineyards: Pratt-Sexton, Marshall, Burnside, Watertrough, Kanzler, Gap's Crown, Thorn Ridge, Freestone

Fermentation: 84% Stainless Steel open tops / 8% Concrete open tops / 8% Wood open tops / 4% Whole Cluster.

Age: 40% New French Oak for 17 months / 6% Concrete tank for 10 months / 15% Wood tank for 10 months
